NA'AMAT CANADA CELEBRATES 90 YEARS



AT A RECENT GALA HELD IN TORONTO NA'AMAT Canada celebrated 90 years. At the same time the event paid tribute to Club Masada, celebrating 70 years with Na'amat and whose oldest active members are all in their 90's, and Club Beersheba, marking its 60 years with Na'amat. These "pajama kids" are cared for from 7 am to 7 pm and are returned home after having been fed three meals and bathed. If not for centre, the children might very well be removed from their homes.
